



EXODUS PULSING

YOU ARE ON GATE ROAD

USE ALL LANES! 10 MPH or less.

YOU ARE IN A PULSE

When Pulsing operations are active, traffic moves forward every hour.

Turn off your vehicle, take a nap, and chill between Pulses. Use the portos, hydrate, and meet your neighbors.

The Pulsing team may dictate flow to account for uneven wait times on Gate Road, or any traffic issues ahead at the gravel road or on County Road 34.

After the Pulsing team has safely cleared the area, the traffic cones are removed and you will hear and see signals that it is your turn to move forward.

MERGE TO GRAVEL

Lanes merge as they flow toward the gravel road. The final stretch is stop-and-go based on traffic flow to the pavement, so stay alert and in your vehicle.

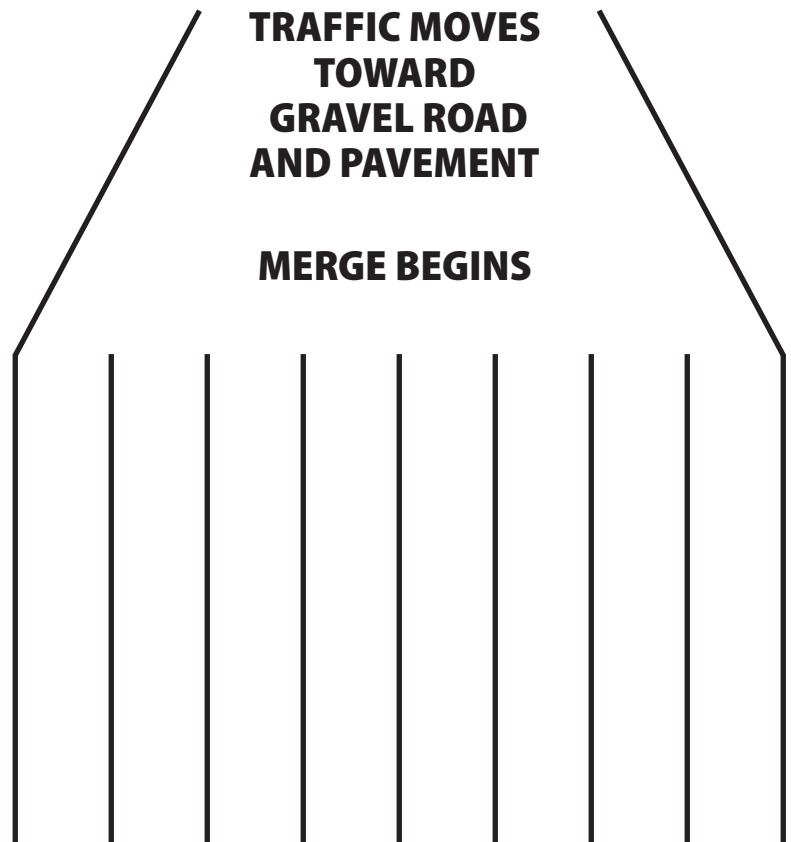
THE NEXT PULSE

Traffic behind the exiting Pulse moves forward until stopped by the exiting Pulse traffic ahead. Lanes are then coned off and you are back in a resting phase.

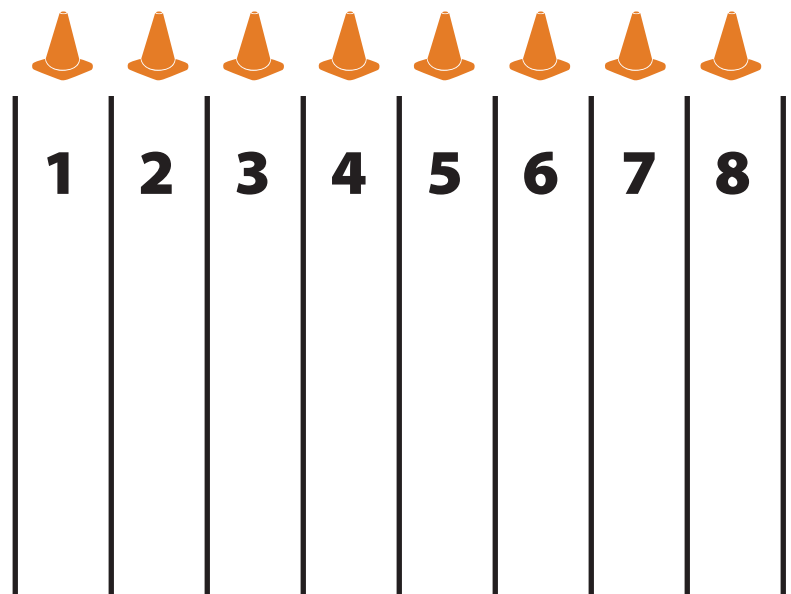
F LOT

Are you still tired? Maybe you need to check that load one more time before pavement? Did you Pulse before your passengers got back in your vehicle? Do you think your vehicle might not make it to pavement?

TAKE IT TO F LOT! Look for the sign (and lights at night) on the right side of the lanes. There will be Exodus team members during peak hours to help sort your issue.
